

**500 Dancers expected for Premiere of World Umbrella Dance at Vancouver Art Gallery April 13** Cherry Blossom Festival Dance Choreographed by Bollywood Superstar Shiamak Davar

**VANCOUVER, BC (Mar. 21, 2013)** – On Saturday, April 13, 500 dancers will meet at the Vancouver Art Gallery Plaza to celebrate the blossoming of Vancouver's 40,000 cherry trees by performing the 2013 World Umbrella Dance, choreographed by Bollywood superstar Shiamak Davar and accompanied by the drums of the Tetsu Taiko percussion group.

Dancers and cherry blossom fans can learn the World Umbrella Dance in just one hour at one of four remaining rehearsals being led by Shiamaks's Vancouver Performance Team. Participants can view rehearsal dates and sign up for the dance at <a href="www.vcbf.ca">www.vcbf.ca</a>. The site features an instructional video of the dance so participants can practise at home, and everyone who signs up will also receive a limited edition PoP- Art umbrella to use in the dance.

The black, yellow and hot pink was created by artist Anthony Redpath is guaranteed to brighten any rainy day. If you love the umbrella and are not able to participate in the dance you can show your support of the Festival and just purchase the umbrella on the website or from the Urban Tea Merchant and VanDusen Garden Shop.

The **World Umbrella Dance** moves to the beat of Shiamak's catchy new release, "Shabop" meaning to dance without worry and celebrate life! This theme is in keeping with the festival's fragile and fleeting cherry blossoms that remind us all to celebrate life now.

The seventh annual *Vancouver Cherry Blossom Festival* (VCBF) will celebrate the return of spring to the city and the blossoming of Vancouver's 55 different varieties of cherry trees from April 4 to 30.

The *Vancouver Cherry Blossom Festival* follows the peak bloom of the cherry blossoms around Vancouver with the *Cherry Jam Downtown* concert being the first public performance of the *World Umbrella Dance*.
